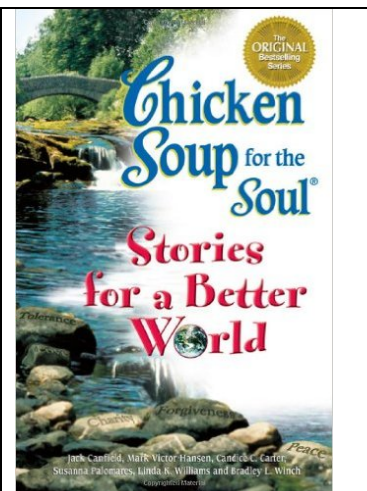


Chicken Soup for the Soul: Stories for a Better World

Upon returning to the United States he came up with the idea to ship cows to Spain to provide milk for the hungry children, which resulted in an organization -- Heifer International <https://www.heifer.org/> -- which has saved and enriched millions of lives.
